

Policy on Cheating

ZERO TOLERANCE FOR CHEATING!

RESTRICTIONS DURING TESTING

- **No Notes.** Put your notes away.
- **No Phone.** Put your phone away.
- **No Help.** Do not ask anyone for help. Do not talk to another student. Do not turn your head side to side or look around.

ACTIONS CONSIDERED CHEATING

- Looking at your notes during testing.
- Looking at your phone during testing.
- Talking during testing.
- If *another student* is attempting to talk to you while you are taking a test, **you and that other student** are considered cheating.
- If you look around, side to side, below the desk, at your lap, or perform other suspicious movements, you are considered cheating.

CONSEQUENCES OF CHEATING

From DCCC's *Academic Honesty* policy:

First Violation – You are assigned a **zero** on the assignment and/or test.

Second Violation – You receive an “**F**” in the course and barred from attending class.

Third Violation – Grounds for dismissal from the College.
