Definitions:

- 1. Having your thumbs in the same spot indicates same sign.
 - a. Same Spot ⇔ Same Sign
- 2. Having your thumbs in a different spot indicates different sign.
 - a. Different Spot ⇔ Different Sign

Begin Here

For any math operation, start with thumbs in this **spot:**

Left thumb: vertical.

Right thumb: horizontal.



Multiplication and Division

<u>CASE 1</u>: Numbers have **Same Sign**.

- Keep thumbs in **Same Spot**.
- See thumbs for resulting "+" sign.



<u>CASE 2</u>: Numbers have **Different Sign**.

- Move left thumb down so that thumbs are in a **Different Spot**.
- See right thumb for resulting "-" sign.



Side 1 of 2

Addition and Subtraction

CASE 1: Numbers have Same Sign.

- Keep thumbs in **Same Spot**.
- See thumbs for resulting "+" operation.
- The "+" indicates addition.
- Add numbers and keep Same Sign.



CASE 2: Numbers have **Different Sign**.

- Move left thumb down so that thumbs are in a **Different Spot**.
- See right thumb for resulting "—" operation.
- The "-" indicates subtraction.
- Subtract numbers and use sign of bigger number.
 - o Bigger "wins".
